

NEWS FROM MLS.ENTOMO

- > Training session in Tunisia / 30 May 3 June 2016. The date for the third and last training has been set for 30 May 3 June 2016 at the Institut Pasteur, Tunis. Save the date! Concerned countries are Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco, Tunisia and also Armenia who wasn't able to join the last course. We already invite the concerned persons (from Egypt, Libya and Armenia, as far as we know) to get information concerning visa issues.
- > Feedback on the training session in Ankara, TURKEY / 7-11 September 2015. The second medical entomology training took place at the Faculty of Science, Hacetteppe University (Ankara, Turkey) from 7th to 11th June 2015. It was kindly hosted by the lab of Prof. Bulent Alten. A mix of lectures, field and laboratory activities allowed the participants to strengthen their knowledge on sampling, species identification and surveillance.

However we are still waiting for data from few other countries. The North Africa countries will be involved after the completion of the third training in Tunis.
